CYCLING HOLIDAYS DONAU-ESCHINGEN – DONAUWÖRTH

Day 1: Individual arrival in Donau-eschingen The Brigach and Breg Black Forest Rivers join to form the Danube near the town, but even the Romans thought the source of the river was located in the park of the Fürstenberg castle.

Day 2: Donau-eschingen – Mülheim/Fridingen (approx. 45 – 55 km) The first stage of your today's bike tour leads you through the so-called „Baar“ landscape. Closed to Immendingen and Möhringen you will be able to witness a unique natural phenomenon: the Danube Sinkhole. Here the river disappears beneath the porous chalk rock for the majority of the year until it resurfaces 12 km further downstream in the "Aachtopf". You pass Möhringen and

reach Tuttlingen. The Danube winds through the rocks of the Swabian Alps.

Day 3: Mülheim/Fridingen – Sigmaringen/Scheer (approx. 45 – 60 km) The bike trail continues beside the river, past romantic mills and picturesque corners of the valley. Soon Wildenstein Castle comes into view. You continue to Sigmaringen. Here you can see one of Europe's largest private weapons collections.

Day 4: Sigmaringen/Scheer – Region Obermarchtal (approx. 50 – 70 km) Today's route starts out in the lovely forests and meadows of the open countryside of the Danube valley. From Scheer via Mengen, one of the five Habsburg towns by the upper Danube, you make your way to Hundersingen. Don't miss Heuneburg Museum with the fascinating exhibit about Celtic settling from 600 to 400 b.C. It winds through Upper Swabia and leads the interested traveller to many historical treasures. The old church of Zwiefalten Convent is known as one of the region's most beautiful churches.

Day 5: Region Obermarchtal/Ehingen – Ulm (approx. 45 – 65 km) There are two options for the journey to Ulm. You can either continue beside the Danube on the familiar

bike trail or take the highly recommended route along the rivers Ach and Blau via Blaubeuren with the impressive "Blautopf" (Blue Pot). Your final destination is Ulm on the border to Bavaria.

Day 6: Ulm – Lauingen/Dillingen (approx. 50 – 55 km) After breakfast you leave Ulm on the well signposted Danube Cycle Path and pass the frontier between Baden-Wuerttemberg and Bavaria. The bike trail leads you via Weißingen to Leipheim, where the St. Veit Church, the Castle, the town walls and city towers are worth a visit. Later on the route takes you via Gundelfingen into the medieval ducal town Lauingen.

Day 7: Lauingen/Dillingen – Donauwörth/Wörlitzstein (approx. 40 – 45 km) Through the nature reserve Apfelwörth you cycle towards your destination, Donauwörth on the Romantic Road, which was highly demanded ever since. You spend the last night in Donauwörth.

Day 8: Individual departure or transfer to Donau-eschingen

- Entrance castle Sigmaringen with guided tour
- Entrance Minster tower in Ulm
- Luggage transfer from accommodation to accommodation
- 1 package of detailed travel information and maps per room
