CYCLING HOLIDAYS DONAUWÖRTH – PASSAU

1. Day: Individual arrival to Donauwörth/Wörnitzstein After your arrival, you have time to stroll around in Donauwörth, a well-known city on the Romantic Road, and to discover the beautiful city with its famous Fugger House.

2. Day: Donauwörth/Wörnitzstein – Ingolstadt (approx. 65 km) In the morning you will start your tour and cycle past Bertoldsheim Castle to Neuburg. You continue through Grünauer Forest to Ingolstadt with its "Liebfrauenmünster", one of the most beautiful hall churches in Southern Germany.

3. Day: Ingolstadt – Kelheim (approx. 55 km + boat trip) Today you cycle along the Danube River until you reach Bad Gögging. There you have a host of opportunities to relax e.g. the well-known Limes spa. Afterwards your journey leads you to Weltenburg, the oldest monastery in Bavaria. Here you can come on board of a Danube steamer (boat trip not included), from where you can enjoy a special landscape.

4. Day: Kelheim – Regensburg (approx. 40 km) Enjoy the unique view over the region of the Liberation Hall on the top of the mountain Michelsberg before you proceed your journey. Your today's destination will be the cathedral city Ratisbon. It is also the northernmost point of the river Danube. Stroll around and discover the beautiful old city.

5. Day: Regensburg – Straubing (approx. 50 km) Crossing the Nibelungen Bridge and the Walhalla Alley, you reach the sign-posted bicycle route "Tour de Baroque" and cycle to Donaustauf. You continue on the Danube dam and past the barrage of Geisling to Straubing, which is renowned for its Baroque

middle-class houses and picturesque city square. World famous and worth a visit is the "Roman Treasure Trove" at the Gäuboden museum.

6. Day: Straubing – Deggendorf (approx. 40 km) Via Oberalteich you reach Bogen at the foot of the precipitous Bogenberg Mountain. The Danube Cycle Path leads you further to Metten, where the twin steeples of the church are clearly illuminated against the soft hilly landscape in good weather. Today's place of accommodation is Deggendorf, the portal to the Bavarian Forest.

7. Day: Deggendorf – Passau (approx. 60 km) Today you will cycle again on the „Tour de Baroque“. Via Niederaltaich, one of the oldest Benedictine Monasteries in Bavaria, you reach the small village of Winzer and then again towards. Vilshofen. You cycle on the left side of the Danube up to the hydroelectric power plant of Kachlet. After crossing the river, you reach the history-charged "city of three rivers", Passau.

8. Day: Individual departure or transfer to Donauwörth

Our package:

- Entrance to Museum Mobile in Ingolstadt
- Boat trip Weltenburg – Kelheim incl. bicycle
- Luggage transfer from accommodation to accommodation
- 1 package of detailed travel information and maps per room
