WALKING TOUR FROM RÜDESHEIM TO KOBLENZ

1. Day: Individual arrival in Rüdesheim

After your arrival take a stroll through the old wine town. If you have enough time, discover the Niederwalddenkmal monument, a famous monument. And you will have a great view of the Rhine valley up there.

2. Day: Rüdesheim – Lorch (approx. 21 km/5.5 hrs)

Start your day ride by cable car (extra costs) to the high ridges of the Middle-Rhine valley. You get a scenic view of the estuary of Nahe. Hike past the hunting fortress Niederwald towards Assmanshausen. Finish in Lorch, a wine town with characteristic features.

3. Day: Lorch – Dörscheid/Kaub (approx. 13 km/4 – 4.5 hrs)

Today you cross the border from Hesse to Rhineland Palatinate. The path you follow is surrounded by a few castles and ruins next to some hills and meadows you walk by. Dörscheid or Kaub are tiny wine towns, where you will stay.

4. Day: Dörscheid/Kaub – Region St. Goarshausen (approx. 19 km/6 hrs)

As legends tell about the fair stone Lorely you probably never expected to see it, or even climb it. Now you get the chance to do it. From there you will get an unforgettable panoramic view. Another special feature is the three-castle view: the castles Katz (cat), Maus (mouse) and Rheinfels (Rhine stone).

5. Day: Region St. Goarshausen – Kamp-Bornhofen (approx. 21 km/6 hrs)

Walk on paths of the nature reserve Filsener Ley which is surrounded by castles, winkled paths and a mythical feeling. Finish the day at Kamp-Bornhofen, where the two castles Liebenstein and Sterrenberg are worth a visit. The two castles originate, so tells a legend, from 'Feindliche Brüder' (hostile brothers).

6. Day: Kamp-Bornhofen – Braubach (approx. 17 km/5.5 hrs)

Today you visit the castle Liebeneck and the mills of Dinkelhofer. Another highlight on your tour is the impressive UNESCO heritage

castle Marksburg. Later on you finish today's walk in Braubach, a wine-grower town with the characteristic timbered houses.

7. Day: Braubach – Koblenz (approx. 20 km/5.5 hrs)

At first you cross a tributary river of the Rhine at Lahnstein and continue to the slide of Kerkertser, as well as the 'Rupertsklamm'. The great final on the last day is the Deutsches Eck (German Corner) in Koblenz, where Mosel and Rhine join.

8. Day: Individual departure
