## CYCLING HOLIDAYS HANN. MÜNDEN – BREMEN

*Tours that are as individual as you!*

**1. Day: Individual arrival in Hann. Münden** Get here early to have a chance to see the numerous half-timbered houses in the city, as well as the gorgeous city hall.

**2. Day: Hann. Münden – Beverungen (approx. 55 km)** After breakfast you start your first stage, which leads to the former Benedictine monastery at Bursfelde, and Oberweser with its open-air milling museum.

**3. Day: Beverungen – Bodenwerder (approx. 59 km)** Today your ride takes you along the border of Solling. You'll pass the Fürstenberg castle, where porcelain is made, before you reach the cloister at Corvey. After that, continue on to the next highlight of the tour: the palace at Bevern, one of the most impressive buildings of the renaissance in Weser.

**4. Day: Bodenwerder – Rinteln (approx. 56 km)** After leaving Boden-

werder, you'll be greeted by the picturesque Hämelschenburg, before being captivated by the Pied Piper of Hameln's song in – where else? – Hameln.

**5. Day: Rinteln – Minden (approx. 41 km)** Today you'll see Bad Oeynhausen, famous for its "Jordansprudel" the largest carbonated hot spring in the world. But things will get a bit tight (literally!) in the valley at Porta Westfalica, the gateway to Westphalia, before you reach Minden.

**6. Day: Minden – Nienburg (approx. 63 km)** Before starting your 5<sup>th</sup> stage you should visit one of the numerous interesting museums of Minden. Along the Weser Cycle Path the landscape changes as you enter the Northern German lowlands and soon you will reach the city Nienburg, where you can explore the old city and its historical sights in a unique way. Just try to follow the bear tracks ...

**7. Day: Nienburg – Verden (approx. 55 km)** On this leg, your ride takes you through little villages filled with red brick houses before you arrive in Verden, famous for its horses. Photo

opportunities abound among the broad meadows, windmills, and occasional farmhouses.

**8. Day: Verden – Bremen (approx. 56 km)** Past the stork nursing station in the outskirts of Verden your today's and last biking tour leads to Bremen. Perhaps you heard the famous town musicians on your ride in, or maybe it was your imagination. Either way, don't forget to check out the statue of them in front of the city hall.
