WALKING TOUR MALERWEG TRAIL COMPLETE

1. Day: Individual arrival in Pirna

We recommend you to take a walking tour through the medieval alleys of Pirna.

2. Day: Pirna-Liebenthal – Wehlen (approx. 12 km/ 4 hrs) In the morning, you take the bus to Pirna-Liebenthal. Today, you will hike through three wild and romantic grounds.

3. Day: Wehlen – Hohnstein (approx. 13 km/ 5 hrs) Not far from Wehlen, you have a picturesque view of the Elbe Sandstone Mountains from the most famous observation deck – the Bastei Bridge. You walk downhill into the ‘Amselgrund’ valley and head for the second highlight of your hiking tour – the Hockstein rock.

4. Day: Hohnstein – Altendorf/Kirnitzschtal (approx. 15 km/ 6 hrs) In the first third of today’s stage, you visit today’s attraction: the viewpoint ‘Brand’. You continue your hike taking 800 steps down into the ‘Tiefen Grund’ valley.

Passing Waitzdorf you reach Altendorf or continue along the Panorama trail, which leads you down into Kirnitzschtal valley.

5. Day: Altendorf/Kirnitzschtal – Schrammsteine – Neumannmühle (approx. 17 km/ 6.5 hrs) Walking on Gratweg trail through Schrammstein massif, you hike directly uphill to Schrammstein viewpoint. Passing Big and Small Dome, you reach Affensteinweg trail which leads you directly to Lichtenhain Waterfall. After visiting the natural arch Kuhstall you hike back down into Kirnitzschtal valley in order to reach the end of today’s hiking tour: Neumannmühle, which is a technological monument. You go back by bus to Kirnitzschtal valley where you will spend the night.

6. Day: Neumannmühle – Großer Winterberg – Schmilka/Reinhardtsdorf (approx. 14/19 km/ 6/7.5 hrs) You start the day taking the bus to Neumannmühle. Then you hike through the rear of the Saxon Switzerland uphill to ‘Zeughaus’. Shortly after, you can experience the stunning Goldstein view and continue with climbing up to the ‘Großer Winterberg’ mountain. After crossing the Elbe river by ferry in

Schmilka (extra costs), you walk upstairs to Schöna and reach Reinhardtsdorf.

7. Day: Schmilka/Reinhardtsdorf – Gohrisch (approx. 17/12 km/ 6.5/5 hrs) Enjoy today’s view on the Schrammstein massif located on the other side of the Elbe River. Before you will reach Gohrisch, you climb up the mesa Papstein and mesa Gohrisch.

8. Day: Gohrisch – Königstein/Weiβig (approx. 9/16 km/ 4/5.5 hrs) Today’s short hiking route on Malerweg trail takes you along Pfaffenstein and cave Diebeskeller until you reach the ‘Fortress of Königstein’. So you have plenty of time remaining to explore what has become famous as the ‘unconquerable fortress’.

9. Day: Königstein/Weiβig – Pirna (approx. 20/13 km/ 7.5/5 hrs) Your last hiking stage on Malerweg trail leads you through Thürmsdorf and Weiβig and uphill to Rauenstein massif. Your final destination is about to be reached: Via Naundorf and Obervogelgesang you reach Pirna in the afternoon – your hiking tour’s point of departure.

10. Day: Individual departure

Our package:

- Luggage transfer from accommodation to accommodation
- 1 package of detailed travel information and maps per room
